

Oaks Men Members:

The 60 and over Senior members had a great tournament in the month of May that is about ready to conclude. It was a outstanding way to meet new people and get some competitive juices flowing.

June will start our second match play tournament so I'm looking for up to 32 interested Oaks members to play. All ages are invited but I will take the first 32 members that sign up and add to the bracket. You need to be flexible to play up to two (2) matches a week and be available throughout the month of June. Please do not sign up if you cannot meet this obligation. The match play tournament will be double elimination. **The tournament will end not later than June 30, 2023.** There will be no exceptions in order to keep this bracket moving. ***Players must sign up/text individually so that I can track entries one at a time by getting your name and phone number.***

USGA & local course rules will be in effect for this tournament. Except in a sand trap, hazard or on the green, the ball will be played up and can be moved up to the distance of a scorecard. Please be courteous if the ball is in the fairway and there is no grass present. A player should be allowed to move the ball to some reasonable grass for a shot in the fairway. Your opponent can provide you with relief, no closer to the hole, to avoid a rough spot that is in your putting line. A player must putt out unless your opponent concedes the putt which can happen at any point. The match will continue until a player mathematically closes out his opponent. In general, a ball within the grip should be conceded to keep play moving however, your opponent may ask you to putt out from any distance as part of gamesmanship so don't assume a putt is "Good."

Players 60-69 will play from Gold Tees; Players 70 and up will play from Red Tees; all others will play from White Tees.

If there are any issues that occur during a match, players will mark their scorecard at that point and refer the issue to me as the tournament Chair following the match to determine the outcome on that particular hole which could lead to replay, penalty, disqualification or no penalty. If the hole in question makes no difference in the outcome of the match, the match is final unless it involves potential disqualification. If the tournament Chair happens to be involved in the match in question, an agreeable third party will adjudicate the disputed rule or potential violation.

**Entry to play in the tournament is \$5** and prize money will be paid out to the winner or winners depending upon the number of entries. For instance, the May tournament had 15 competitors and will pay two (2) places. If you get into the tournament, the entry fee must be paid not later than your second match or you will be disqualified from further play.

I will determine if junior or senior high school students playing on the local golf teams can receive monetary prizes.
